This fishing derby is for children up to age 12.

Sign up for the fishing derby at the Kiwanis Booth located in front of French Louie ADK Sports and the Adirondack Reader.

- **Each child is allowed to sign up for 1 one-hour time slot to fish on the floating raft anchored on Fifth Lake. (10:30, 11:30, 12:30 & 1:30)**
- **Please write child's name, city & state where from, and parent's email address.**
- **Circle the number next to child's name. This number will be written onto your color-coded wristband, and will be used to keep track of the fish caught by each child.**

Catch a ride on one of the barges behind Inlet Town Hall to take you to the raft.

Barges will be moving people to and from the raft all day. Please get on and off the raft as close to your time slot as possible, to allow enough room and time for all children to fish.

Children need to be accompanied by an adult while fishing on the raft. One adult should not be responsible for more than 3 children.

There will be staff on the raft to assist the children with baiting their poles and someone keeping track of all fish caught and released.

Fishing poles, life jackets and worms will be provided. However, you are welcome to bring your own pole and/or life jacket.

Winners will be announced and prizes awarded in front of French Louie ADK Sports at 3:00 p.m.
