Rules for all Kitefliers:

Safety and fun are our objectives. For safety, you have to follow these rules. For fun, you need to follow them with a smile on your face and remember that this is an event organized and run by volunteers who work very hard to ensure everyone has a safe and fun time.

Construction

- Your kite must be approved before flying.
- Your kite must be free of any cutting string (Manja).
- You should keep in mind, while decorating your kite, that if the decorations make the kite too heavy or change its center of gravity, your kite might become difficult to fly.

Participation

- The pilot must have read and understand the rules and register their kite before flying.
- The pilot must get on and off the ice at designated areas and stay within designated “flying” area during their time on the ice.
