# Inlet, NY "TO DO LIST"



During the Summer or Fall...

- Hike a mountain:  Rocky,  Black Bear,  Bald (fire tower),  Wakely (fire tower),  Stillwater (fire tower)  Blue (fire tower) or  West
- Hike to a waterfall at  Cascade Lake or  West Pond both near Eagle Bay/Big Moose or  Death Brook near Raquette Lake
- Explore some virgin White Pines towering 150 feet in the air at Cathedral Pines between Inlet & Raquette Lake
- Walk out onto a bog to explore the plants and maybe get a glimpse of boreal birds at Ferd's Bog in Inlet near Eagle Bay
- See the loons, ospreys and other birds around Moss Lake near Eagle Bay/Big Moose
- Fish for bass, pike, trout or pan fish on the Moose River or the Fulton Chain of Lakes
- Go for a swim at a free public beach (lifeguards on duty) at  Inlet's Arrowhead Park or  Old Forge Beach
- Play tennis on the public courts at  Inlet's Arrowhead Park or  Old Forge Lakefront
- \*Enjoy a book, video, newspaper, or check your e-mail at the  Inlet Public Library or  Old Forge Library or  Raquette Lake Library
- Set up camp at one of the many camping areas: Free Camping:  Moose River Recreation Area,  Moss Lake or DEC Paid Camping:  Alger Island,  Browns Tract Pond,  Eighth Lake,  Golden Beach,  Limekiln Lake,  Nicks Lake or a Private Campground:  Old Forge Camping Resort,  Singing Waters
- \*Ride the rails on the Adirondack Scenic Railroad in Thendara (daily excursions, weekly skit, canoe & mountain bike shuttles)
- Enjoy NY State's largest water theme park at the Enchanted Forest/Water Safari
- Rent a canoe, kayak or SUP in Inlet:  Clark's Marina or  Frisky Otter Tours, Big Moose:  Dunn's Boat Service or Old Forge:  Mountainman or  Tickner's to take to any of the many lakes within the Adirondack Park streams
- Play miniature golf in Inlet:  Putterfingers or in Old Forge:  Calypso's Cove or  Nutty Putty
- Rent a mountain bike in Inlet:  Pedals & Petals or Old Forge:  Mountainman Outdoor Supply Co. and explore the many trails in the area
- Go horseback riding with Adirondack Saddle Tours in Inlet, near Eagle Bay
- Rent a motorboat, pontoon boat or fishing boat in Inlet:  Clark's Marina, Big Moose:  Dunn's Boat Service, Eagle Bay:  Palmer Point or Old Forge:  Rivett's Marine
- Take a chairlift ride and see the whitetail deer and an awesome view at McCauley Mountain Ski Area
- \*Visit View (the arts center in Old Forge) to view the ever changing exhibits on display or take part in one of their activities
- \*Deliver the US mail on the morning rounds with Old Forge Lake Cruises' Mailboat
- \*Cruise Adirondack lakes aboard  Raquette Lake Navigation,  Dunn's Boat Tours,  Old Forge Lake Cruises,  Stillwater/Beaver River Noridgewock Adirondack Wilderness Cruise or  Blue Mountain Lake Boat Livery, Inc.
- \*Take a narrated dinner cruise aboard the W. W. Durant of Raquette Lake Navigation
- \*Visit the  Inlet Historical Society or the  Town of Webb Historical Association exhibits
- \*Enjoy watching first run films on the four screens at The Strand Theatre in Old Forge
- Play 18 holes of golf at the  Inlet Golf Club or the  Thendara Golf Club
- \*Learn about the early Adirondack logging industry at the Northern Logger's Exhibit Hall & Museum in Old Forge
- \*Take a ride to the Adirondack Experience, the museum on Blue Mountain Lake
- \*See an Adirondack Great Camp at Great Camp Sagamore in Raquette Lake
- Get a bird's eye view of the Adirondacks aboard a seaplane at Payne's Air Service in Inlet
- Take a guided canoe or kayak tour with Frisky Otter Tours
- \*Hit the unique shops, restaurants and pubs along, and just off, Route 28 from Thendara to Raquette Lake

During the Winter...

- Cross country ski at Fern Park or the Inlet Golf Club in Inlet or McCauley Mountain in Old Forge
  - Explore the snowy Adirondack forest on snowshoes
  - Go ice skating at the Fern Park Pavilion in Inlet or at the outdoor rink in Old Forge
  - Ice fish on the Fulton Chain of Lakes, Limekiln Lake or Raquette Lake
  - Go sledding at Fern Park in Inlet or at McCauley Mountain in Old Forge
  - Downhill ski at McCauley Mountain Ski Area in Old Forge
  - Snowmobile on 100's of miles of groomed snowmobile trails on the interconnected Town of Webb & Inlet trail system
